NatureHood is a program of Nature Canada created to inspire urban residents to connect with nature through innovative programming, celebratory events and stewardship activities set in urban green spaces and Important Bird and Biodiversity Areas.

The Young Naturalists Club is one of the grassroots naturalists club across Canada that promotes NatureHood at the local level, exposing the next generation of naturalists and citizen scientists to nature all around them.

NatureHood started in 2012 with a pilot program in Ottawa and the YNC joined the program in 2015. Since then we have held many events and developed activities around birdwatching and migration, and promoted urban youth and residents to connect with nature.
